**Reading:** The story we will be reading this week is “Alexander, Who Used To Be Rich Last Sunday” there will be a test on Friday. Please encourage your child to read the story at home at least twice this week.

**Math:** We will be working on rounding a number to the nearest hundred, estimating sums and differences of three-digit numbers, comparing and adding fractions with denominators of 2, 3 and 6 using pattern blocks, writing a fraction to show part of a whole, and subtraction facts 5 and 6.

**English:** We will be working with words that have final double consonants, subjects and predicates, time and order words, the suffix -ly, and cause and effect.

**History:** We will be learning about the Buildings of Rome, Gladiators and Chariot Races, Pompeii, The Romans and the Christians, and The Decline of the Roman Empire.
