Math: We will be working on rounding numbers to the nearest 10, using logical reasoning to solve a problem, working backwards to solve a problem, naming and drawing polygons, dividing a square into three equal parts, identifying thirds, rewriting numbers and regrouping by tens and ones, and trading dimes and pennies.

English: We will be working on verbs, sentence variety, the /o/ sound, and talking more about how to use a dictionary.

Science: The class has done very well during the science unit on sound. We will be finishing up on Monday talking about Ben Franklin. There will not be a test on this unit. I have assessed the kids in class.

History: We will begin studying and locating important rivers in the world.
