Dear Parents,

You will be receiving Third Grade News every Friday. It will inform you of the classroom events and weekly assignments. I am very excited to have a wonderful group of students. Below is some information that will be helpful for next week and the rest of the year.

- **SPELLING:** path, lamp, damp, crash, plant, math, trash, stamp, hatbox, have, grass, rags, back, black, that **The spelling pre-test is Wed. any student who scores 100% will not have to take the test on Friday!*
- **Memory:** The memory for this week is the following: “The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to Him in song. Psalm 38:7 **This will be a fill in the blank test on Friday*
- **Homework Folder:** Each student possesses a green folder that is marked as his or her “homework” folder. This folder will carry the student’s homework back and forth from school and home. Please make sure the folder comes back every day. Please check your student’s planner. Each day, we as a class, write down all our assignments for the day and I sign it before they leave. Please check to make sure that my initials are at the bottom for each day. Please also sign under my initials every night. Signing will tell me that you have reviewed your child’s homework and that he/she has shown you everything he/she need to. When homework is forgotten the student will need to redo it at recess.
- **Graded papers:** Your child will receive his/her graded work on Friday and other handouts from the week in a red folder. Inside the folder will be a place for you to sign. This will need to be signed by a parent or guardian and sent back to school on Monday.
- Every day, we will have D.E.A.R. time and the students are encouraged to bring chapter books from home. I have many books in the classroom that they can borrow to read, however, they might prefer something from home.
