Reading: This week we will be reading the story "Uncle Jed's Barbershop" *there will be a test on Thursday because of our field trip on Friday.* Please keep encouraging your child to be reading the story during the week.

Math: We will be working on division facts by 2 and 5, working backwards to solve a problem, subtracting two- and three-digit numbers, comparing and ordering unit fractions with denominators of 2, 3, 4, and 8 using fraction strips, and adding and subtracting fractions with like denominators of 2, 3, 4, and 8.

English: We will be working on reviewing effective beginnings and endings, prepositions, subjects, predicates, parentheses, possessive pronouns, subject/verb agreement, and comparative/superlative adverbs.

Science: We will be looking at space travel and spending time having centers for the class to gain insight from additional resources. **Remember that Planet Reports are due on April 30th!**
