Memory: Sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth. Psalm 96.1

Reading and Language: We will be learning about Xx, Zz, writing sentences, nouns, reviewing short vowel sounds, word games, extending sentences, blending, using words to make a sentence, double constants, and the sh sound. We will be looking at the decoable books: *Trash, Jen Dreamt, Run and Pass, Dogs and Cats, and Zack the One Man Band.*

Math: We will be exploring using a ruler to draw a line segment, sorting common objects, adding two digit numbers without regrouping using dimes and pennies, estimating and measuring using nonstandard objects, and combining geometric shapes to make new geometric shapes.

Science: We are still learning and exploring our solar system. We are talking about the planets, sun, and moon. The kids are really enjoying this unit! **Please remember that your child was given a report and a project that are due January 30th.**
