Memory: Please continue to work with you child on the words to the Christmas Program songs. I added the words in a link on our class blog. Please go to <http://www.calvaryslz.org/thirdblog/> and select Christmas Songs to get the words if you need them again.

Reading and Language: We will be exploring the letters Bb, Cc, Rr, and Uu, adjectives, final consonant substitution, blending, word building, main idea and details, counting syllables, sound/spelling chain, an alphabet cheer, and listening for letters. We will also have a few decodable books and will be reading the following stories: "Spiders", "Mice", and continuing "Munch Crunch: The Food Animals Eat".

Math: We will be working on counting dimes, counting by 2's, telling time to the hour, subtraction facts: subtracting 1 and subtracting a number from itself, estimating the capacity of containers, ordering containers by capacity, and identifying a 1-cup liquid measure.

History: We will be finishing up our unit on US Symbols and Figures. We will be making a booklet of the symbols we learned, talking about the President and the White House, and will be playing US Symbol Bingo.
