Memory: Christmas program learning is underway. Please work with your child in memorizing this verse. Sing a song of Christmas. Sing a song of the King. Reading and Language: we will work on blending one syllable words, restoring final constant sounds, and the letter sound /h/. We will also be having our first unit wrap up assessment on Wednesday and Thursday. The students will be taking a test on word boundaries, high frequency words, vocabulary, classifying, and grammar. This is a review of everything we have talked about so far and things your child should know. If we move at a faster pace next week we will also be starting our next unit called "Animals".

Math: We will be working on addition facts: Adding 1, sorting items and creating a graph, weighing objects using nonstandard units (part 2), finding a sum by counting on, making and reading a bar graph, and using logical reasoning to solve a problem.

History: We will be learning about US Symbols and Figures. We will be doing a brief review of symbols learned in Kindergarten then moving on to the Liberty Bell, and the American Flag.
