Reading: This week we will be reading the story "The Tree House" and there will be a test on Friday. Please have your child read the story at home during the week. This can count as part of their required reading time.

Math: We will be working on making a design with pattern blocks, writing the date using digits, dividing squares into two, four, and eight equal parts, identifying and shading halves, fourths, and eighths, reading a thermometer, rounding numbers to the nearest 10, and addition facts of adding by 2.

English: We will be working on comparing and contrasting, verbs, topic sentences, word structure, and the /i/ sound.

Science: We are studying sound and the human ear. We will be looking at the bones and parts of the ear and doing experiments about sound and pitches.
